



Membership Registration – Checklist

After a skater has been participating in group lessons for a while, he/she often considers exploring other opportunities such as individual lessons, individual competitions, team skating, and so on. By joining the Saratoga Springs Figure Skating Club (SSFSC), a skater may:

- secure an United States Figure Skating (USFS) membership
- skate on club ice at a reduced fee to practice skills and receive individual instruction
- participate in shows, tests, competitions, and social activities hosted by the club
- explore new opportunities such as synchronized skating
- enjoy the camaraderie and friendships that come with club skating



SSFSC is affiliated with US Figure Skating. When a skater joins SSFSC, he/she will also join and become a member of US Figure Skating. USFS is a national organization that provide opportunities for skaters to compete, test, and participate in other sanctioned events. USFS memberships need to be renewed annually but transfer with the skater no matter what club he/she chooses to belong to in the future.

Saratoga Springs Figure Skating Club annual membership runs from July 1 through June 30. To join the club, or renew membership, skaters must submit a:

- completed Membership Registration Form AND
- a signed Skater Code of Conduct AND
- a signed Parent Code of Conduct AND
- membership fee payable to SSFSC for payment in full
